



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Maccungy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing 151 Acres 100 Perches of Land, with the usual Allowance for Roads That was Surveyed unto John Adam Overcarst by Warrant of the 12th April Anno 1753. Who afterwards Sold his Right to the Same. Unto Baltzer Yeackle, whose Heirs sold the same again unto Michael Overcarst. Surveyed the 15th May Anno 1755.
