



Situate in Windsor Township York County containing within the black lines as above set forth twenty seven acres, One hundred and twenty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 58 ac 68 perches & allowance. Originally Surveyed by William Matthews late DS on the 31st day of the 3^d month AD 1767 in pursuance of the Application of John Fisher N^o 2942 dated the 2nd day of March AD 1767 Resurveyed by Jacob Spangler late DS on the 24th day of March 1813 and a piece of Vacant land added thereto in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property dated the 1st day of February 1813. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the said 24th day of March 1813 and now at the request of John Overdorff the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined, corrected, and returned for confirmation January 15th 1822.
