



Situate on the Waters of Milk and Water Run in Providence Township Bedford County Containing 197^{cs} & 132 P^{cs} and allowance of 6 P^{ct} Surveyd for Peter Oneal the 28th day of April 1814 (by James Piper Esq) in Pursuance of a Warrant for 188^{cs} dated the 30th day of Dec^r 1813 Examined by me on the ground the 11th day of December 1824

Note. The above survey was returned by James Piper Esq was sent back not excepted to John Wolf Esq stating that Mr Pipers note as to interference with Samuel Proviance N^o 642^{was} too Vague. Therefore from adraught found in my office the above Survey would appear to be the same that was Resurveyed for Samuel Proviance the 28th day of June 1799 on an Order dated the 1st day of August 1766 N^o 642 but not stated by whoes Surveyd or Resurveyd But by another Draught found in my office containing 276^{cs} & 66^{cs} Surveyd in 1767 on the above named Order by Richard Tea their Deputy Surveyor & the lines Examined on the ground by W^m Piper Esq April 16th 1802. it would appear from the order & the last mentioned Survey together with what information I can collect that the Land mentioned in the above named Order must lie between 3 and four Miles from Peter Oneals Survey
