



Surveyed to Robert Neal on the 28th of February 1838 the above described Tract of Land included in the black lines containing two hundred Acres one hundred twenty Eight perches and allowance of six per cent &c. Situate in Wayne Township Armstrong County on the Waters of Cowenshannoc Creek. Being part of a Larger tract Warranted in the name of T. Pickering, Samuel Hodgedon Durcan Ingraham, and Tench Cox containing in all Eleven hundred acres and thirty two perches with the allowance of Six p^ct &c Surveyed to them on the 27th of May 1786 in pursuance of a Warrant dated 17th May 1785.
