



Situate formerly in Fishing Creek now Sugarloaf Township Columbia County Surveyed by William Montgomery Esquire deputy Surveyor on the 28th day of December 1793 unto Daniel McHenry Jun^r by Virtue of his Warrant bearing date the 13th day of August 1793 Containing four hundred and fourteen Acres and forty nine perches and the usual Allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c as appears by the Original Draught Remaining on file in my Office Witness my hand at Danville the 10th day of March AD 1823
