



The Draught of a tract of land Situate in West Buffalo township Union County Surveyed the 24th day of January 1824 for Catharine Chambers Executrix and Joseph Musser Executor of the last Will and Testament of Robert Chambers Deceased Containing Ninety Seven Acres & twenty one perches with the Usual Allowance of Six Per Cent &c. It being formed of a part of two adjoining tracts of land. One thereof Surveyed the 9th day of December 1772 for John M^e Kee in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date 9th day of November 1772. The other Surveyed the 10th day of December 1772 for William Moore in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the 25th day of August 1772.
