



Situate on a Small Run that empties into Susquehanna River, adjoining Lands of Charles Smith and others on the West Side of big Mashannon Creek in Huntingdon County, containing 420 Acres 68 perches and the Usual allowance for Roads. Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 8<sup>th</sup> Day of January 1793.
