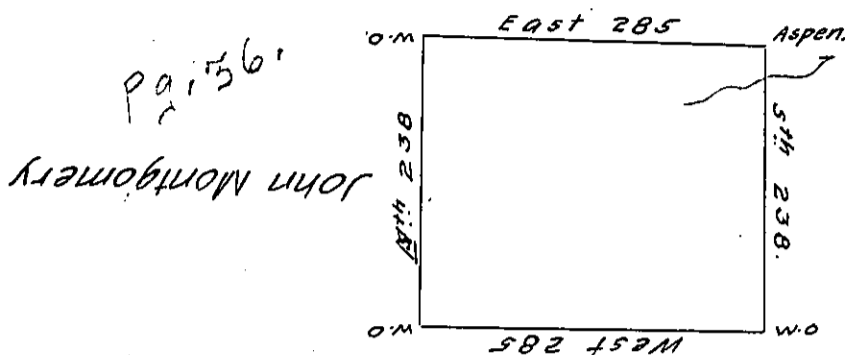

The above is the draught of a Survey made December 7<sup>th</sup> 1794, in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Montgomery on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792, situate Northwest of the Ohio river, on the Waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to John Montgomery, called Bramyard, containing four hundred Acres, with the usual allowance of 6 p. Cent &c.
