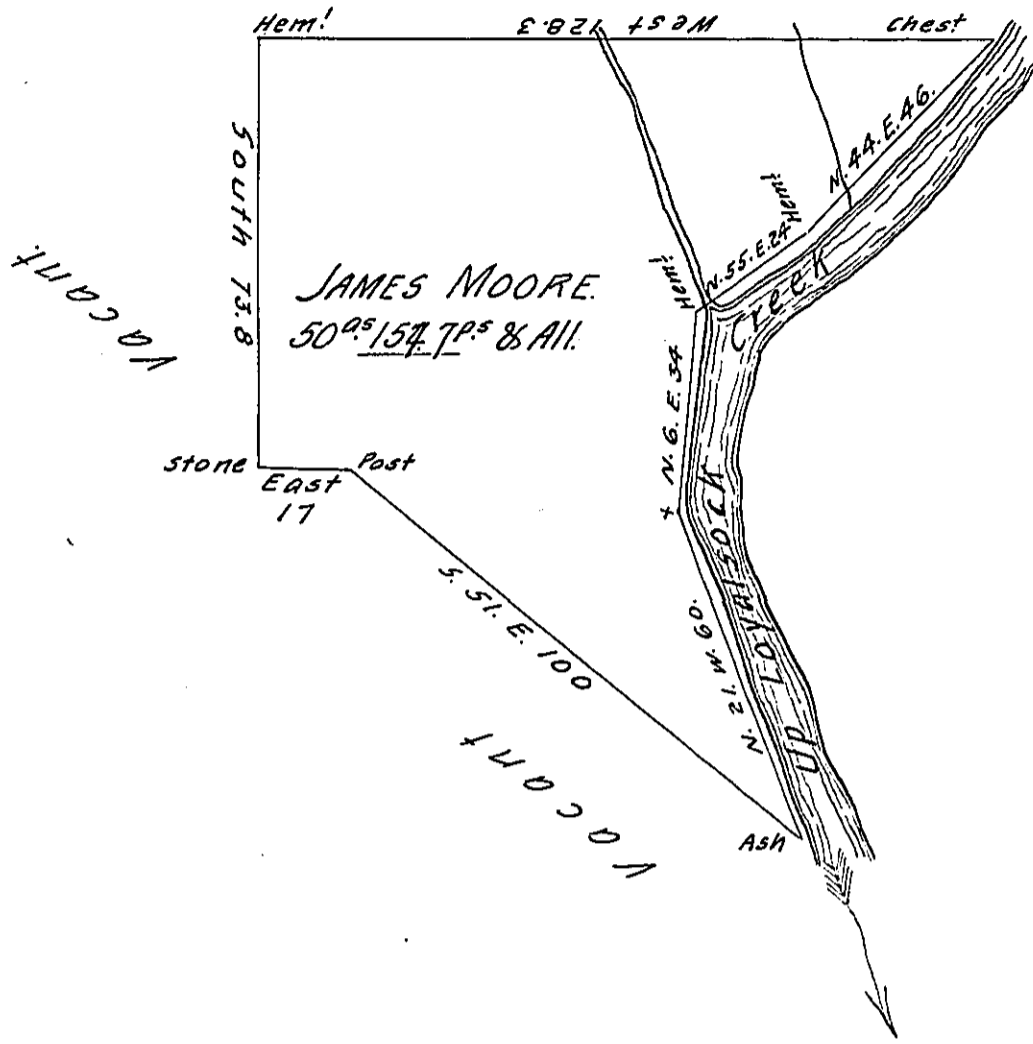


James Moore.
