



A Draught of a tract of Land Cauled — Situate in the East end of Hisha-  
 coquillas Valley, (Cumberland Now) Mifflin County. Containing Eighty Six Acres 135  
 perches with the usual Allowance of Six percent for roads &c. Surveyed the  
 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Decr. 1766, In pursuance of an Order of Survey to William Power,  
 bearing date at Philadelphia the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 1766, No. 1061.

Examined the above Survey this 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 1847, for John & William  
 McNitt, who appears to be the present owners and found to be correct.
