In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned, and by Virtue of a Commission Under the hand and seal of Office from John Lukens, Esq<sup>r</sup>. Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783, the Above tract of Land Containing two hundred and Sixteen Acres and one hundred and fifty Six Perches and allowance of 6 <sup>fr</sup> Cent for Roads &c. Was Surveyed on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1785, by
