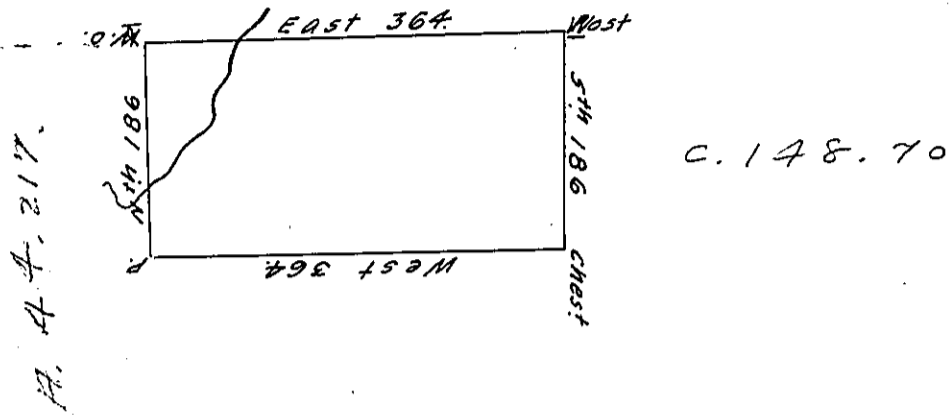

The above is the draught of a Survey made December 8<sup>th</sup> 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Miller on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to William Miller, called Brandor, containing  $\bar{f}$  399 Acres & 28 perches with the usual allowance of 6 p<sup>r</sup> Cent & c<sup>a</sup>
