Containing One hundred and Sixty nine Acres and Eighty five perches and the usual allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads 85^c Surveyed the 22nd day of June 1767, in pursuance of a Warrant from the Honourable the Proprietaries to William M^cNitt, bearing date at Philadelphia the 8th day of September 1755, And said to contain 176^a 8 15 ps. Resurveyed the 31st day of May 1837, by old Marks on the ground,

Examined the above at the request of John & Robert M^cNitt, the present owners this 13th day of July 1847, and found to be as above represented
