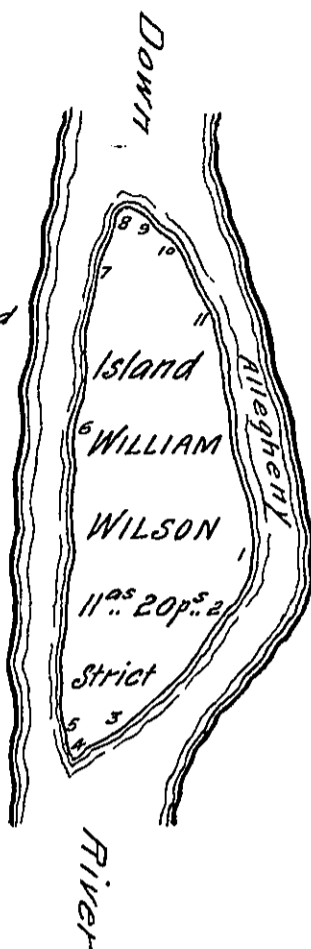

Surveyed December 12, 1860, In pursuance of a warrant granted to William Wilson bearing date the 8th day of December, 1860 the above described Island containing Eleven Acres and twenty perches Strict measure, Situate in the Allegheny River, in the township of Pine and county of Armstrong known as the "Wyant Island" located about two and a half miles below the mouth of the Mahoning Creek
