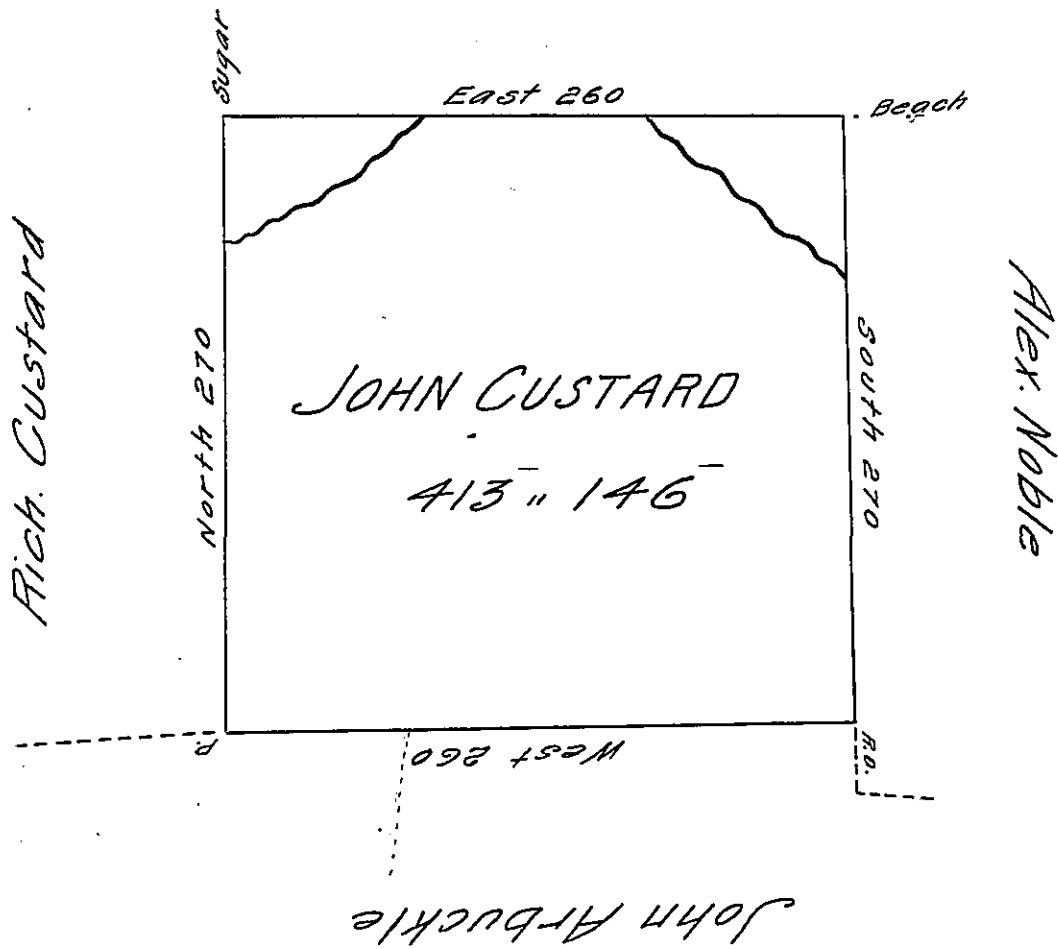


Vacant, or Settled J.C.
