



Situated in Tyrone Township Adams County Surveyed October 13th 1809 In pursuance of a warrant granted to Francis Crum for 196^a dated August 23rd 1809 the part marked **A** is part of a larger tract on which Samuel Carson paid five pounds to Rich^d Peters as appears by his receipt Dated 10th March 1742 Signed Richard Peters for Leynford Lardner **B** is part of a larger tract formerly owned by Sam^l Neely both said large tracts were surveyed by George Smith sometime between the year 1742 & 1748 for which it is said there can be no warrants found
