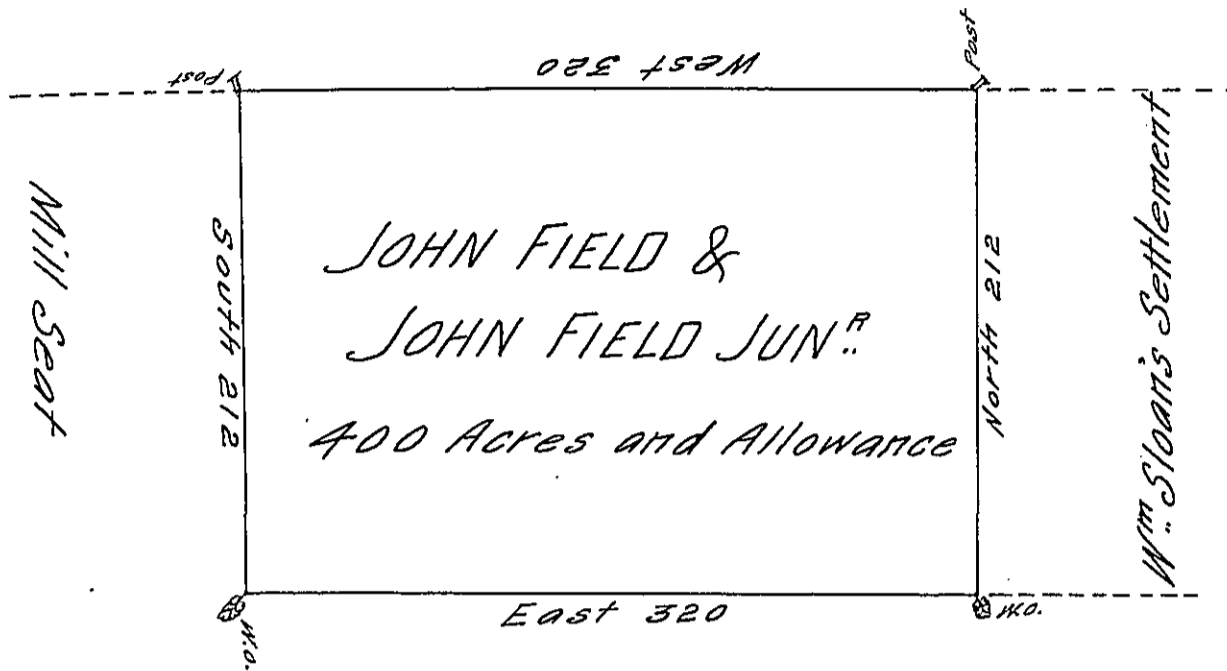


Joseph Riddick's Settlement

In pursuance of an Improvement made on the _____ by James Fearis who is said to be the Tenant of John Field & John Field Jun^r. there was survey'd for the said John Field and John Field Jun^r. the above described Tract of Land containing four hundred Acres with an allowance proportioned to Six & Cent Situate on the North and West side of Allegheny River about two Miles from said River in District N^o 5 in Allegheny County Survey'd October 20th 1798.
