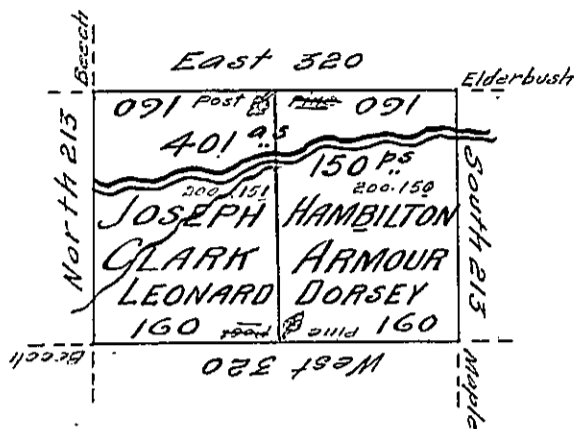

Situate on the west side of French creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches & allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Resurveyed the 12th July 1799 In pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres granted to Leonard Dorsey bearing date the 30th May 1792 [It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 6th Nov^r. 1794 for Samuel Dunn on his improvement dated 5th Nov. 1794.
