



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400 Acres granted to Charles Flake baring date the 21<sup>th</sup> of April 1794 was Resurveyed the 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 1817 the above discribed tract of land containing 401<sup>ps.</sup> 150 perches and allowance of six per. cent for Roads &c. It being the same tract of Land which was surveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of November 1794 for William Miller in pursuance of his improvement baring date the 1<sup>th</sup> day of November 1794 situate in East Salem Township Mercer County Bounded north by Crawford County line and south by the south line of district N<sup>o</sup>. 2 known by W<sup>m</sup>. Power's district, and there appered to have been cleared & upwards of ten acres of the same —
