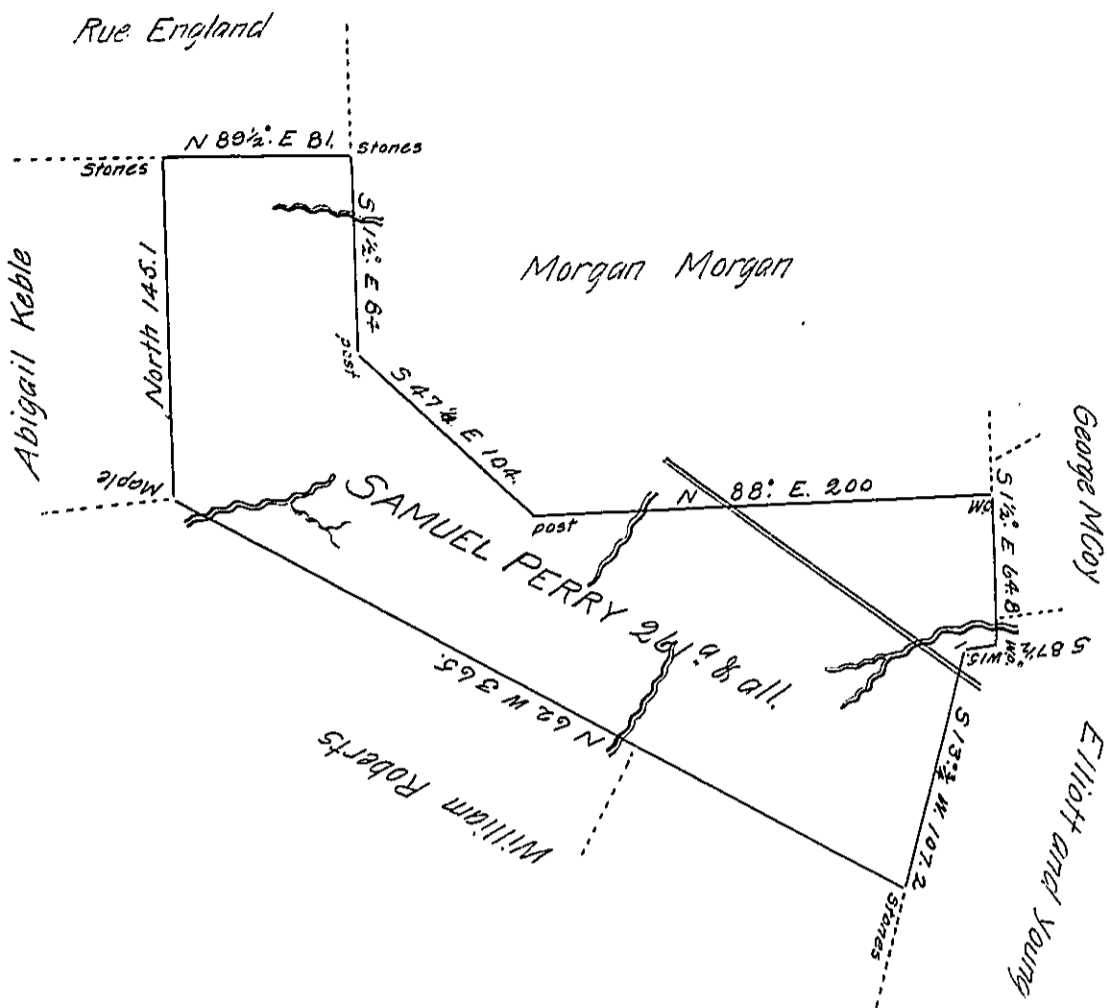


Returned 17th June 1797 by William McCall and Recorded in Book I page 109. And now Copied, to prevent disappointment in Case of Misconriage.
