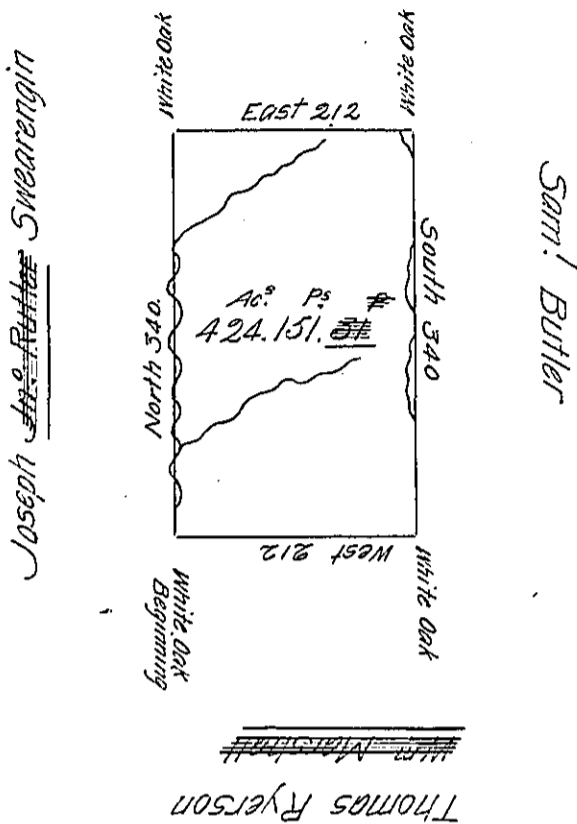

The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 26<sup>th</sup> of January 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Purviance for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794 Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Big Beaver Creek. & twenty four  $\frac{3}{4}$  thirty one poles Adjoining Land Granted to Thomas Ryerson Called Clayburn Containing four Hundred Acres and the Usual Allowance of Six P<sup>ct</sup> Cent for Roads.
