



In pursuance of a Warrent dated the 20th day of May A.D. 1806 granted to James Peden Surveyed a Small Island Situate in the River Susquehanna in Martick Township Lancaster County being about fifty perches below the landing of McCall's Ferry about ten perches from Lancaster Shore and about Thirty perches to the Eastward of McCall's large Island, Caled Tobes Island; the 21 May 1806. P.
