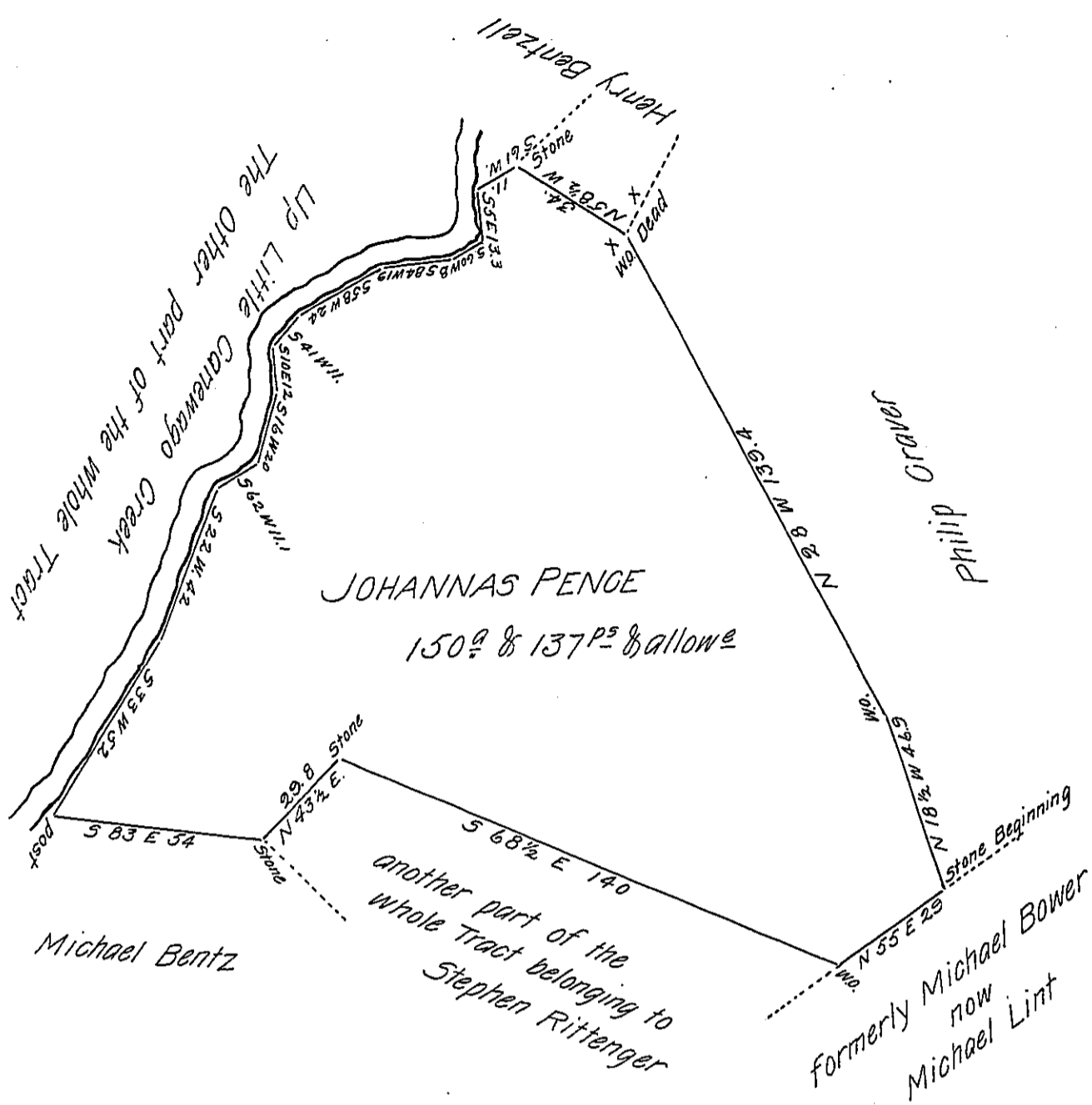


FORM No. 1.



Situate in Manchester <sup>now Westmanchester</sup> Township in the County of York, being part of a larger tract of land originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of the 4<sup>th</sup> Month 1765 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Johannis Pence for 150<sup>1/2</sup> bearing date the 22<sup>d</sup> day of November 1749. Re-surveyed and divided off from the Said Whole Tract on the Third day of April 1799. by John Forsyth late D.S. Containing as above Set forth 150<sup>1/2</sup> & 137<sup>1/2</sup> prches and allowance. And now at the Request of the Present Owner George Nailor I am directed to Calculate and Return the Same for Confirmation the 29<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1809.
