In Consequence of a Certificate Granted by Commissioners appointed by the State of Virginia to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio, of which the following is a true Copy.— We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio. do hereby Certify that John Purdy is Entitled to Three Hundred Acres of land lying and being in the County of Yohogania on the Waters of Little Redstone creek to include his Settlement made in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Four. Given under our hands at Redstone old Fort this Fifteenth day of November 1779, in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
