



Situate in Manheim Township in the County of York containing as above set forth 90<sup>ac</sup> of 158 perches and allowance. Being part of a larger tract of land which was originally surveyed by Archibald M<sup>c</sup>Glean late D. S. on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1770.
