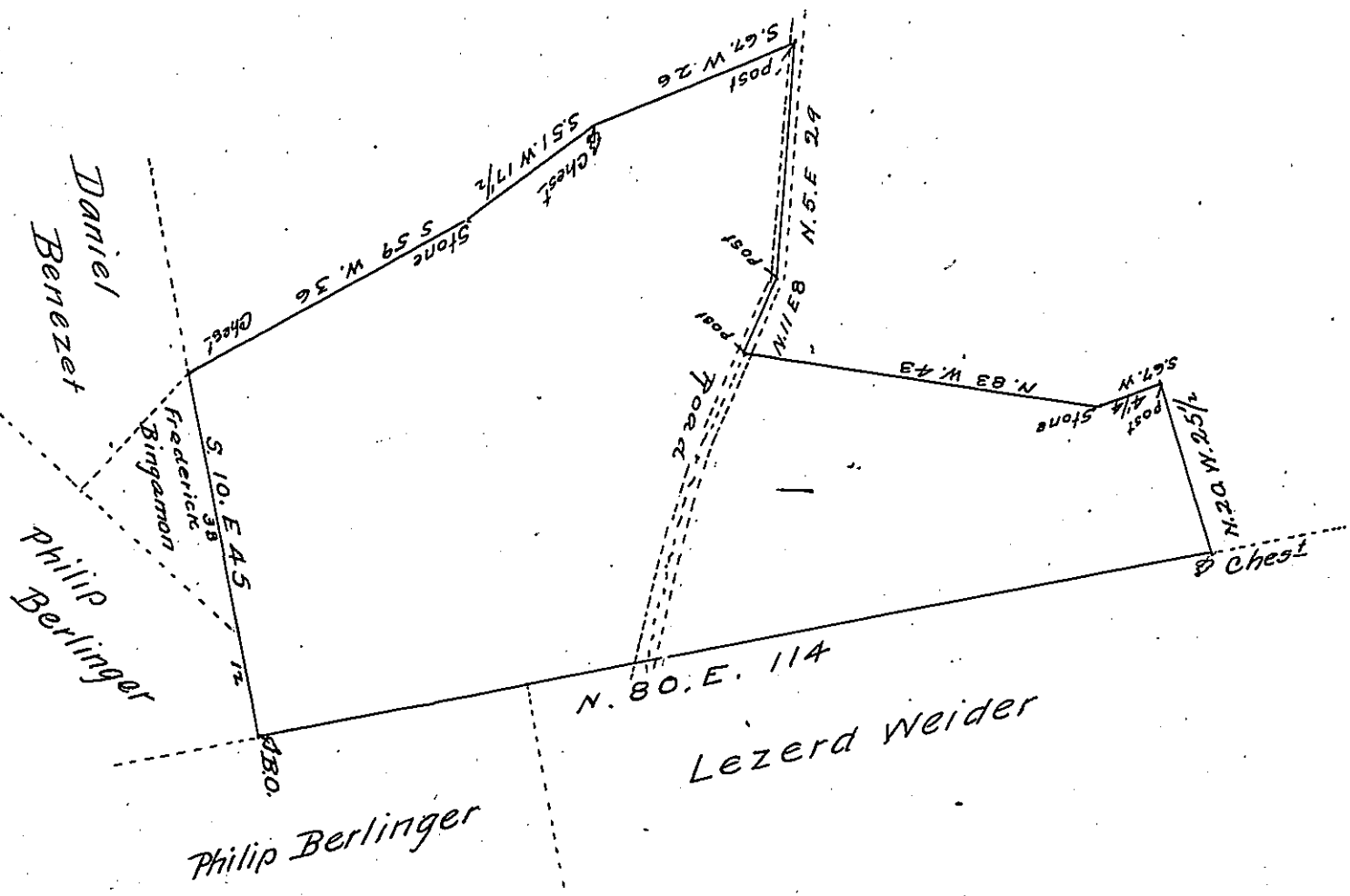


Philip Pfuhl's Land
