



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3 day of July following for Evan Owen on a Certain lot of ground situate in the town of Sunbury in Northumberland County marked in a general plan of said Town Number 273 Containing in Breadth East and West on Hurtleberry Street sixty feet and in length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Hurtleberry Street. Eastward by River Street. Northward by Raspberry Alley, and Westward by Lot No 274. Returned into the Secretary's office the 24th March 1774

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this sixth day of April 1906
