



By Virtue of ^{an} order on the application of Isaac Goldrea or Coulden N^o 347 dated the 5th day of August 1765 the above described tract of land containing Two hundred and seven acres & a half and allowance of six p Cent. was surveyed the 28th day of ~~the~~ November then next following to John Scull.

Situate now in Manhiem Township, ^{Berks} County. Copied from the field works of Mordecai Yarnall who surveyed for John and Jasper Scull. Certified the first day of Juny 1796
