



Situate on the East side of little Juniata River adjoining and above the Mills of formerly Andrew Porter's in Warrior mark Township and County of Huntingdon containing Three hundred and Seventy one acres and thirty two perches and the usual allowance of Six p Cent for roads &c. Surveyed the twenty seventh day of June 1797 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Mary Porter dated the 6 day of July 1795 for 400 acres
