 ship Luzerne Co. Surveyed on a warrant granted to Christopher Marshall  
 dated 21st. Sept. 1792. Showing the part patented; the Interference with  
 the Joseph Robinson tract and the part for which Harrison Brandon has  
 filed his application for a patent; being the whole of the unpattented  
 part containing One hundred and forty three Acres ten perches & allow-  
 ance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed for Harrison Brandon  
 April 1st. 1871- constructed the above Draft Feb. 7th. 1881.
