 laid down was Surveyed by George Smith
 in Pursuance of a Warrant for 250a. dated the 2d. day of

March 1742 but not Returned and Resurveyed for John Patterson and Andrew Patterson by the
 Old Lines the 12th. day of May 1790. By Moses McGlean. Dy. Sr.

N. B. Andrew Patterson had taken a new Warrant for the One hundred Acres but as
 the whole had been Surveyd on David Maxwells Warrant I did not think it my duty to Execute
 the new One.
