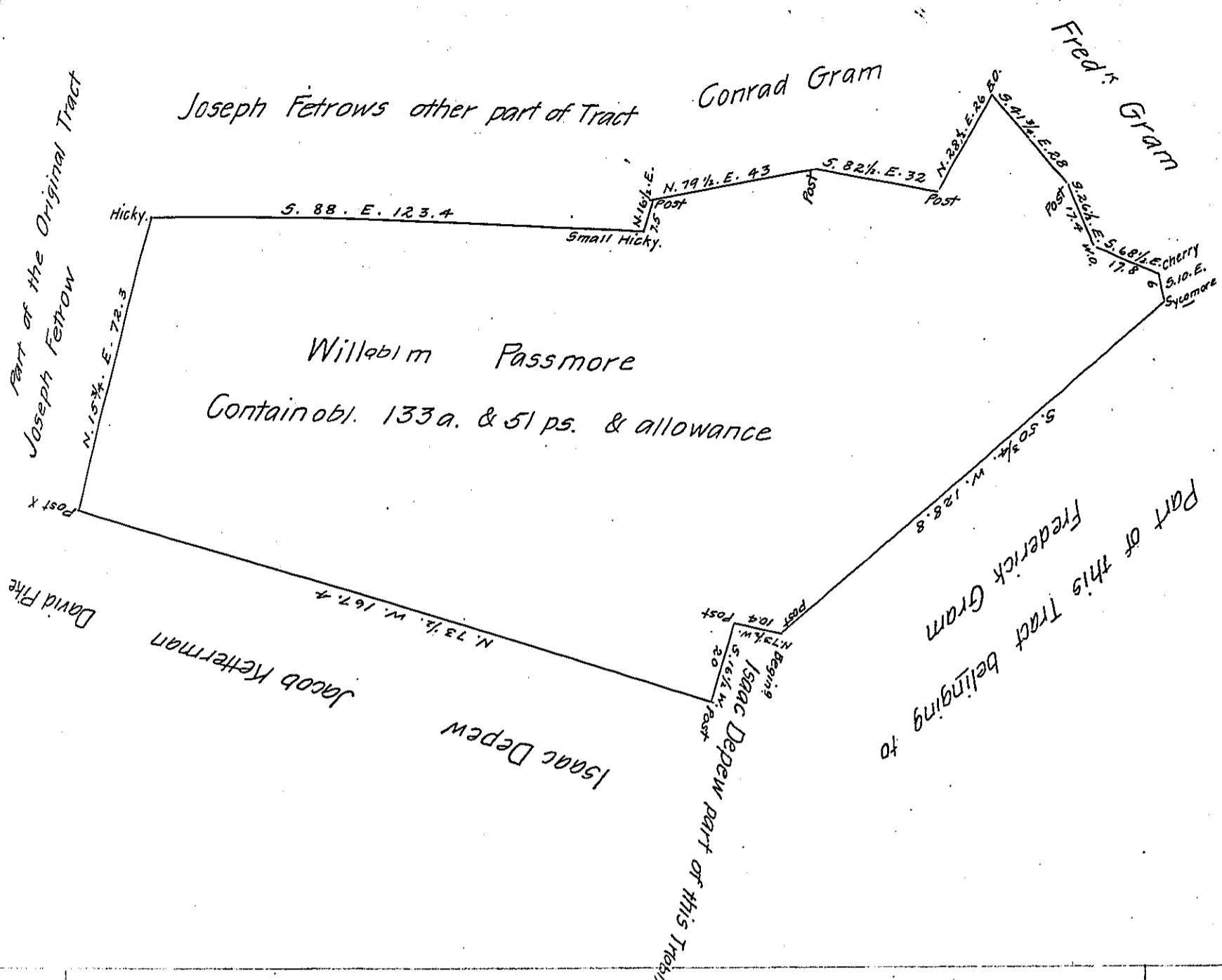

Situate in Fairview Township in the County of York Containing  
 as above set forth 133 acres & 51 ps & allowance, Being part of a larger Tract  
 of Land, which was Originally Surveyed on the first day of March 1783 by  
 Charles Lukens late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 500 acres, granted  
 to William Passmore bearing date the first day of December 1743. Resurveyed  
 and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 17th. day of August  
 A.D. 1809 for Daniel Brookhart, the present owner, who desired me to make  
 a Return of the Draught.
