



The Square

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772. A Survey was made on the 3d day of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, being numbered in the general plan of said Town, Ten, and granted to James Mc Neal containing in length North and South One hundred and Seventy feet and in Breadth East and West Sixty feet, bounded Southward by the Square Eastward by Lot number Eleven, Northward by Mulberry Alley and Westward by Lot number Seven as by the general Plan remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 15th of January 1773 by warrant dated the 14th of the same month.
