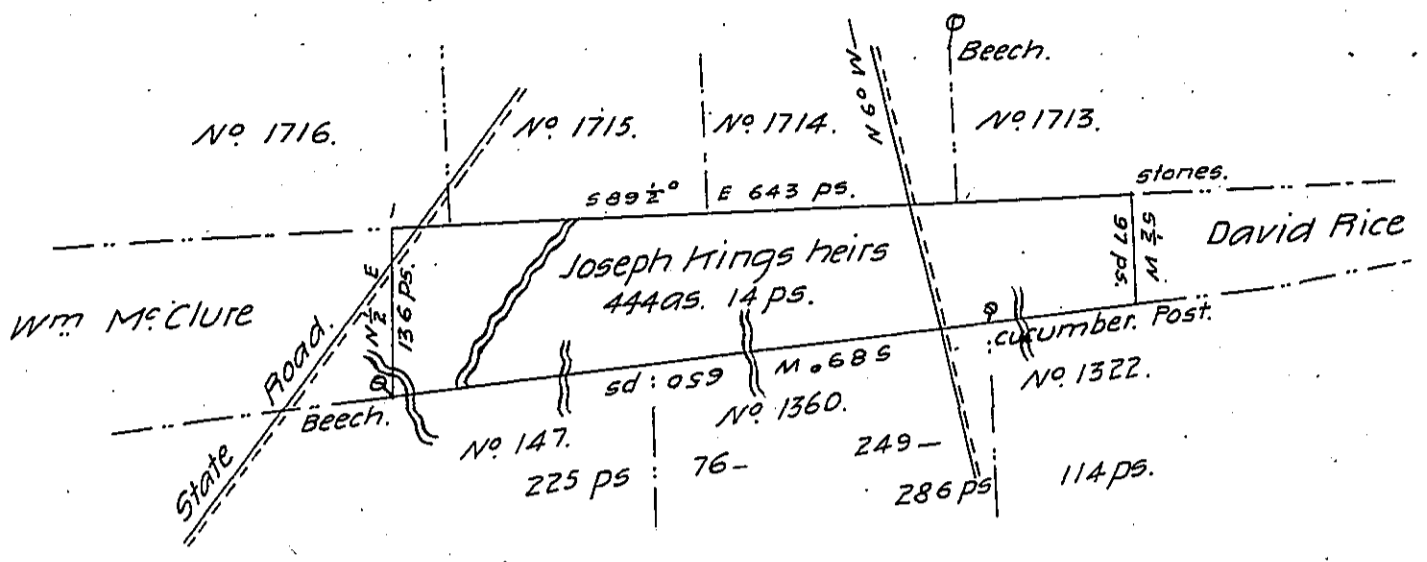


Eighth Donation Dist.

In pursuance of Joseph Kings actual settlement and improvement made the beginning of December 1819, was surveyed September 5th 1848 for John H. Osburn who is now intermarried with the widow of Joseph King deceased, the above described tract of land, containing 444 as. and 14 perches, and allowance of six pr. cent for Roads &c. Situate in Athens Township in the County of Crawford; and is now transferred by the heirs & representatives of Joseph King to the said John H. Osburn.
