



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 3d of September A.D. 1792, Surveyed the 19th day of November A.D. 1866 to Thomas Odion or Odion (for Patenting) the above described tract of one hundred and fifty four acres and one hundred and thirty five perches with six per cent allowance for roads &c. situate adjoining land of Eliphalet Gillet and others in Colley Township Sullivan County Pennsylvania being part of a tract, the balance being interfered with by Jacob Ritzer and Richard Tomlinson warrants as shewn by dotted lines thereon. (The original return being 424 1/2 as. & allowance as surveyed Oct. 1st 1793.)
