



A draught of an island situate in the river Susquehanna in Manor township Lancaster County called Catfish Island lying about one hundred & fifty yards from the Ring Rock which is at the landing of Sowers ferry now owned by Jacob Charles & others lying a south West course from said Rock and about one hundred yards from the Lancaster shore containing thirty six perches strict measure surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated 25th of February Anno Domini 1822 granted to John Mellinger Sen^r.
