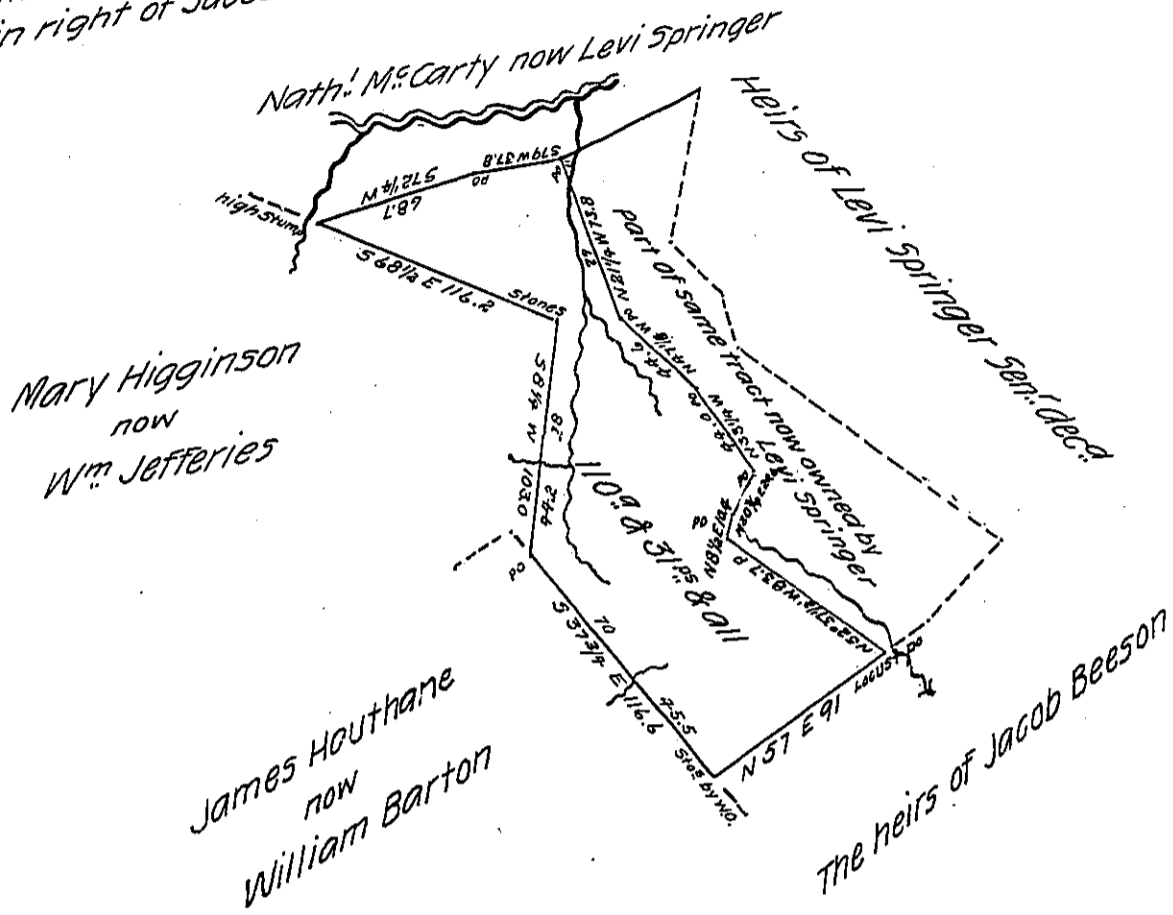


The directors of the Poor & house of employment in trust for the County of Fayette

Situate on the east side of Jennings's Run on the National road in Union township Fayette County & surveyed the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1829 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Jacob Murphy for 200 acres dated the 2<sup>d</sup> day of June 1786

There is about 75 acres cleared a large brick house & barn & on this part of this tract and the paupers of the County are maintained & employed on the same this part of the tract is now returned at the request of the "directors of the poor & as they wish to obtain a patent in behalf of the County
