



A draught of one hundred and eighty three acres and allowance of six P cent &c<sup>a</sup> situate on Cananawango Creek in Little Britain township Lancaster County one hundred and twenty six acres and forty five perches & allowance of six P of part of a tract of 393<sup>a</sup> 120<sup>a</sup> first granted on the 21<sup>st</sup> July 1734 to William Fulton and in the year 1742 resurveyed for James Gillaspie by George Churchman and the fifty six acres and one hundred and fifteen perches & allowance &c<sup>a</sup> was surveyed for the said James Gillaspie By warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> March 1743

Returned into the Secretary's office the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May 1774 the 126<sup>a</sup> 45<sup>a</sup> for George Ross and James Bickham Esq<sup>ts</sup> by warr<sup>t</sup> dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1774 granted to William West Joseph Swift George Ross and James Bickham and the 56<sup>a</sup> 115<sup>a</sup> returned the same day of James Gillaspie by warrant dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1743.
