



In pursuance of an order from the commissioners of property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for John Kerr on a certain lot of ground in the town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general plan of said town No. 264 containing in breadth East and West on the south side of Blackberry street sixty feet and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet bounded Northward by Blackberry street aforesaid Westward by River Alley Southward by Gooseberry Alley and Eastward by lot No. 263 returned into the secretaries office the 17th day of August 1774 for John Ream by warrant dated the 16th day of August 1774

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventeenth day of May 1906
