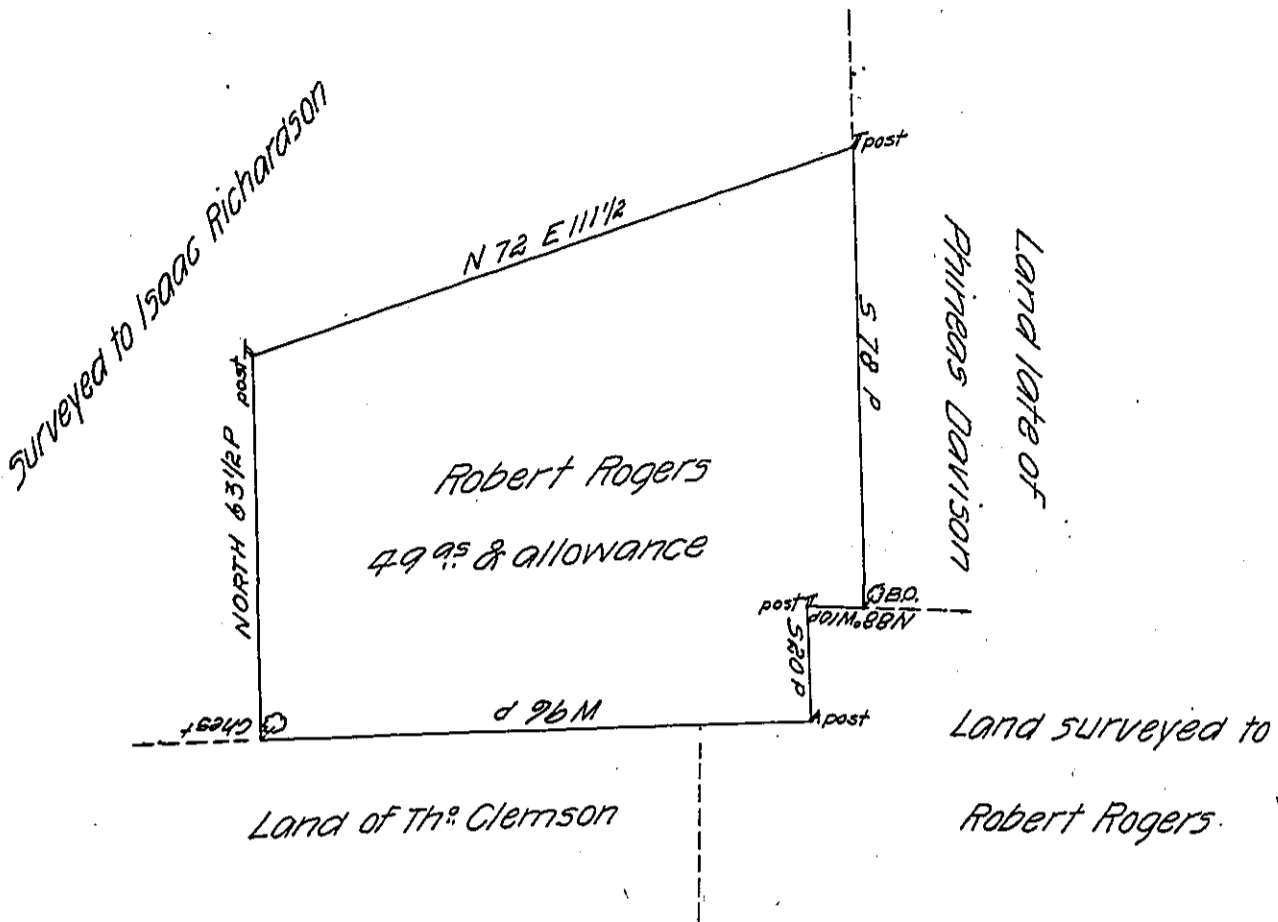


Warrant to accept this Survey dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Apr 1767



Pursuant to an order on the application of the above named Robert Rogers (N<sup>o</sup> 473) dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1765 the above described tract of land was surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>mo</sup> 1767 in West Cain township in Chester County containing 49<sup>95</sup> beside the allowance of six P cent taken off of Isaac Richardson's survey pursuant to the judgement of the board given forth the 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1766.
