



*A draught of a lot of ground situate on the W<sup>t</sup> side of Earle street in the town of Reading in the County of Berks marked in the Gen<sup>l</sup> plan of 5<sup>d</sup> town No. 141 surveyed for Josiah Reese returned into the secretarys Office the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March 1767 for 5<sup>d</sup> Reese in pursuance of a warrant dated the 18 same month*
