As then Surveyed and returned to the Land Office of Pa. By resurveying it proves to contain Six Acres and Eighty Six perches & Allowance outside of the Interference with the Manor line which was Surveyed a long time ago. I therefore return the remaining part of the Survey into the Surveyor General's Office of Pa. to be patented to Jacob Ament of Franklin Township, Westmoreland County, Pa.
