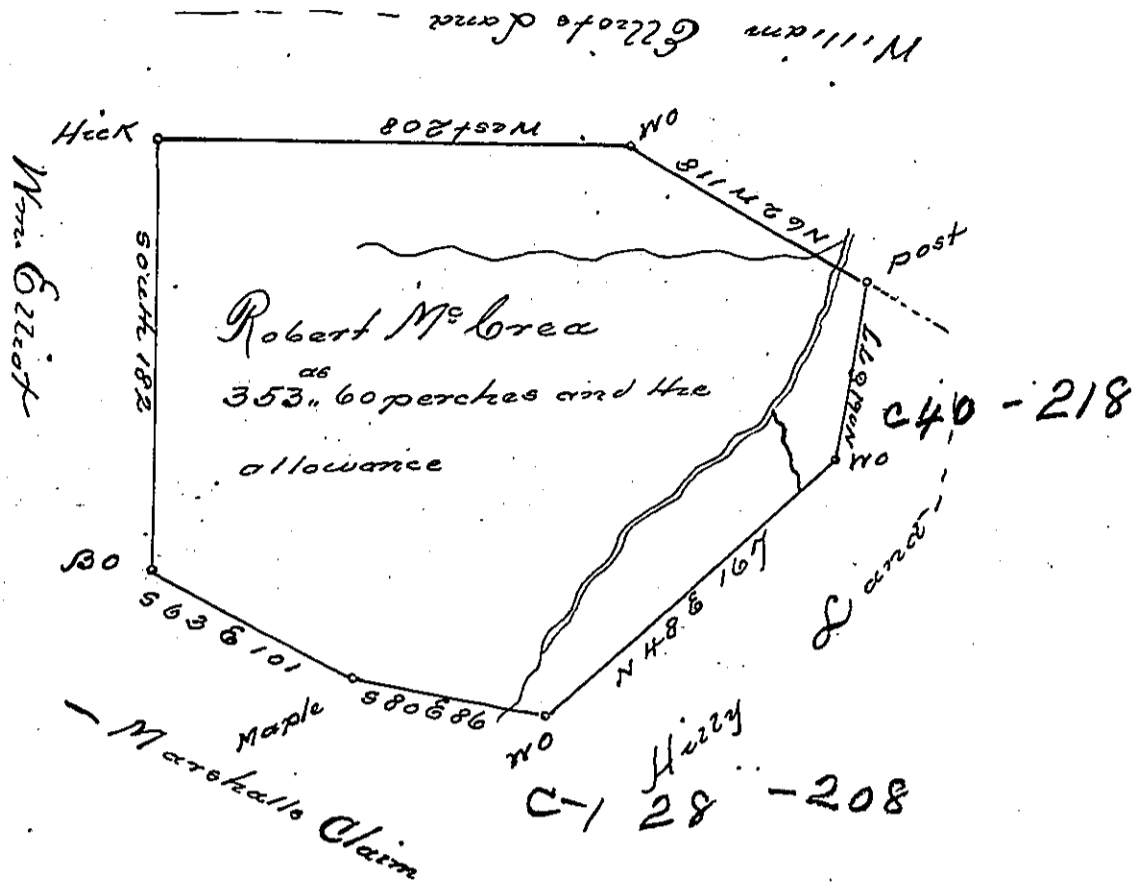

In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of June Anno Domini 1773. Surveyed for Robert McCreach the above described tract of land (called Fitchme not) containing three hundred & fifty three acres with an allowance proportioned to 6 per cent situate adjoining Lands of William Elliot on a thickety road emptying into Bruckey run including a yellow Spring near the Road to Fort Pitt in Westmoreland County. Survey'd the 30<sup>th</sup> of June 1773.
