



The Draught of a Tract of Land called Thornton Park, Situate in Buffalo  
 Valley, part in the County of Berks, and the residue in Cumberland County  
 Containing Two Hundred seventy five acres 38 perches with the usual allow-  
 ance of six acres 70 Cent, for roads. Survey'd the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August Anno Domini  
 1771, in pursuance of an Order of survey to Thomas Mackerness. Bearing  
 date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 3<sup>d</sup> day of April Anno Domini 1769, N<sup>o</sup> 942.
