



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772, a survey was made on the 3^d day of July following for Mease and Caldwell on a certain lot of ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in a General plan of said town, Number Eighty four, containing in breadth North and South on the East side of Broadway fifty seven feet six inches and in length along the north side of Parkberry Street two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by Broadway, Southward by Parkberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by River Alley, and Northward by Lot number Eighty three Returned into the Secretarys Office the 21st day of March 1774 by Warrant dated 2^d Jan^y 1773.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirtyfirst day of October, 1905.
