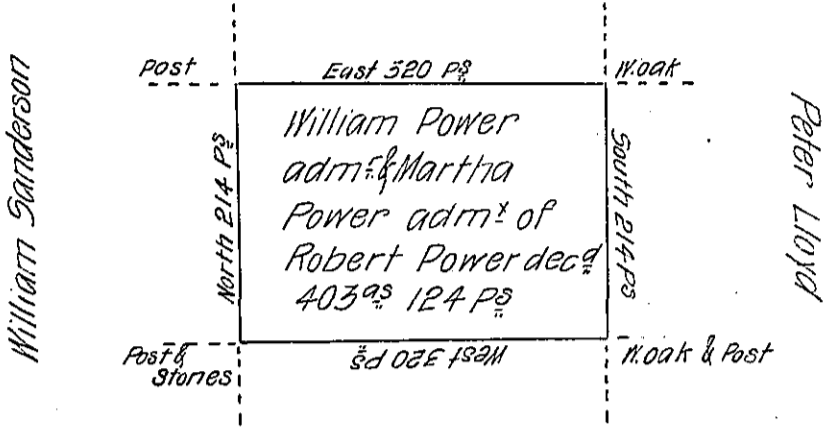

Situate in fallowfield township. Crawford County Pennsylvania.
