Surveyed the 16th day of May Anno Dom 1822 for William Patterson in right of Galbraith Patterson containing two hundred and sixty one acres and one hundred and thirty five perches with the usual allowance of six P. Cent & C. It being part of a tract of land which was Surveyed the 7th day of August A. Dom. 1769 for Galbraith Patterson by Virtue of his Order of Survey bearing date the 3^d day of April A. D. 1769. No. 560. Pr William Maclay Esq then Deputy Surveyor of Berks & Cumberland Counties.
