



By Virtue of a Warrant granted to Jacob Palm, dated the 24th day of May A. D. 1774 there was resurveyed on the 23^d day of November A. D. 1819 (by Henry M. Richards for John U. Epler then Deputy Surveyor) unto George Ege Esquire in right of the said Jacob Palm, the above described Tract of land, situate in the townships of Heidelberg, partly in Berk & Lancaster Counties. Containing Nineteen acres and twenty three perches and the allowance of six percent for Roads &c.
