



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1872, a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> of July following for Jesse Yarnall on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number forty one, containing in breadth East and West on Shamokin street sixty feet, and length North and South two hundred and thirty feet, Bounded Southward by Shamokin Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number forty, Northward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number forty two. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1874, for Robert M. Bride by warrant dated the 6<sup>th</sup> Instant.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this twelfth day of October, 1905,
