



In pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1892. a survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1892. on a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in General Plan of said Town Number forty two, containing in Breadth East and West on Shamokin Street sixty feet, and in length North and South two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Southward by Shamokin Street aforesaid Eastward by Lot Number forty one, Northward by Mulberry Street, and Westward by Fawn Street. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1894 for Robert M. T. Bride by warrant dated the same day
